

## Well Jesus, what about him?

But let none of you be ... a **busybody** in other men's matters. 1 Peter 4: 15

Jesus said **what I have for him is not your concern. Follow me.** John 21: 21

What about (them) do we call down fire and burn them up? Luke 9: 54-55

Lay hands suddenly on no man, neither be partaker of other men's sins: keep yourself pure.  
1 Timothy 5: 22

What about her? Should we kill her? John 8: 4-11

**Have your faith to yourself before God** Romans 14: 22 Have you faith? Have it to yourself before God....

And that we may be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men: **for all men have not faith**, but the Lord is faithful, who shall stablish you, and keep you from evil. 2 Thessalonians 3: 2-3

**Men commandments** and doctrines Colossians 2: 22

- You must be in a building on Sunday and follow their dress code
  - Follow their way they worship
    - Pray publicly - Matthew 6: 5-6
    - Give publicly - Matthew 6: 1-3
    - Give them 10 percent (1 Samuel 8: 7-18 the “church” of today?) (Bottom line is) And ye shall cry out in that day because of your (preacher) king, which you shall have chosen you; and the **LORD will not hear you in that day.**
    - Give your money to them and not your parents/family Matthew 15: 6
- Don't eat these foods (whatever they say is bad) - Matthew 15: 11
- Don't drink this (whatever they say is bad)
- Don't smoke

Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world. James 1: 27

**Busybodies** “used apparently of a person officiously inquisitive about other's affairs”

For we hear that there are some which walk among you disorderly, working not at all, but are **busybodies**. 2 Thessalonians 3: 11

And withal they learn to be idle, wandering about from house to house; and not only idle, but tattlers also and **busybodies**, speaking things which they ought not. 1 Timothy 5: 13
