"they Praised the Stuff" They drank wine, and praised the gods of gold, and of silver, of brass, of iron, of wood, and of stone. Daniel 5: 4

But hast lifted up thyself against the Lord of heaven; ...**thou hast praised** the gods of **silver**, and **gold**, of **brass, iron, wood, and stone**, which see not, nor hear, nor know: and the **God** in whose hand thy breath is, and whose are all thy ways, **hast thou not glorified**: Daniel 5: 23

"He died" In that night was Belshazzar the king of the Chaldeans slain. Daniel 5: 30

"Rachel took Daddy's stuff " With whomsoever thou findest thy gods, **let him not live**: ... For Jacob knew not that **Rachel had stolen them**. Genesis 31: 32
Rachel died at birth of her next child Genesis 35: 19

... he which shall be upon the housetop, and **his stuff in the house**, let him not come down to take it away: and he that is in the field, let him likewise not return back. **Remember Lot's wife**. Luke 17: 31-32
